## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

By entering Tent City, patrons, contractors and event staff agree to the following conditions of entry:

- Patrons must keep their site clean and tidy within clearly marked lines.
- All vehicles, trailers, camping gear and patrons must strictly fit within allocated camping space/s.
- Adhere to the Event Organisers' or Queensland Health's COVID-19 requirements at all times.
- Must not behave in a threatening or inappropriate manner (aggressive, riotous, abusive, or insulting actions) towards other patrons or Event staff.
- Must present their camping wristband to gain re-entry
- Must sign in and scan out at all times of entry and re-entry with the Tent City Covid-19 check-in QR code
- Rockynats Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or evict patrons to/from the campground who do not comply with the conditions of entry.

## SITE RULES

- 1. Must adhere to onsite 8km/hr speed limits
- 2. No alcohol
- 3. No amplified music
- 4. No use of generators
- 5. No animals (other than trained assistance dogs)
- 6. No digging of holes
- 7. No star pickets
- 8. Use of tent pegs must be no greater than 150mm
- 9. All fuel must be stored in containers that meet the relevant Australian Standard for the type of fuel being stored and as per QLD Government regulations total additional quantities may not exceed 250L per vehicle. Fuel containers must remain within the contestant's vehicle at all times and no refueling of vehicles or equipment is permitted on site
- 10. Must adhere to onsite noise rules between 9.30pm and 7.00am
- 11. No unauthorised guests
- 12. Must maintain social distancing
- 13. No prohibited items (see below)

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following restricted and prohibited items are not permitted into Tent City:

- Glass
- Illegal substances, including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs
- Flares or fireworks
- Laser pointers
- Weapons, or resemblance of weapons, including knives, firearms, blunt offensive objects, batons and those with sharp ends
- Projectile items, including balls, Frisbees, rackets or similar objects
- Bicycles, skateboards, skates, scooters and helmets of any form
- Political or offensive materials
- Recording devices (for commercial purposes) and tripods
- Selfie sticks
- Flag poles of more than 1 metre in length / banners or flags larger than 1m x 2m
- Animals (other than trained assistance dogs)
- Musical instruments and noise makers, including drums, whistles, air horns and loud hailers
- Other items as determined by RRC that may cause injury, public nuisance or safety concern
