



Mr Rockabilly-nats 2022 Pin-up Competition

Terms and Conditions

Each entrant is required to carefully read these Terms and Conditions before completing the application form attached. Upon application, the entrant agrees to comply with these Terms and Conditions to be considered for finalist selection.

1. Rules and Regulations

- All entrants must be 18 years of age and over.
- Completed application forms, including bios, must be attached at the time of the application to be eligible for finalist selection.
- By submitting the application all entrants are agreeing to have their photograph taken, with the potential to be used in media for following Rockynats events. If you do not wish for your photographs to be used in media or promotional material, please seek the advice of one of the organisers.
- Finalists will be chosen at the discretion of the Selection Panel and all decisions are final.

2. Competition Requirements

- The theme of the competition is "Rockabilly and Rockynats"
- One outfit is to be worn throughout. Dress codes must reflect the best of 'Rockabilly-nats' and can include the option to wear the highest of heels, big hair, your most glamour vintage-inspired frock or something to get down and dirty in. Whatever you feel captures 'Rockabilly' and the car culture of 'Rockynats'.
- There is one section to the competition: a catwalk and 1-minute routine.

- All entrants are then requested to participate in the Street Parade on Friday the 15th from 11.30am – 1.30pm before the competition commences on the Main Stage at 2:30pm.
- Winners and entrants are invited to activate the CBD precinct for photo opportunities as part of the Show 'n Shine and cruising. Hours are flexible and more details will be revealed closer to the date.
- Winners are to be available to present Rockynats awards at the showgrounds and burnouts at 6pm-7pm and 4:15-4:30pm respectively. Select entrants may be requested in the absence of winners.
- Please let organisers know of your availability at your earliest convenience.

3. Code of Conduct

- As representatives of the Miss Rockabilly-nats competition, each entrant will be expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and professional manner at all times during the Rockynats event.
- Nudity and lewd behavior is prohibited. Rockynats is a family friendly event and any such behavior will result in disqualification.
- Entrants will not slander or negatively comment on the pageant, other Contestants, Judges, Rockynats Management or Staff, or anyone else involved with, or connected to Rockynats. Entrants will not engage in any defamatory verbal and/or written remarks against Rockynats. Event Organiser's, nor the Rockynats event or any social media platforms. If this occurs it will result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of any and all prizes and awards won, and potentially legal action
