



Accreditation Process – Application:

- Online application portal to be opened in February
- A link will be sent to all businesses and residents to complete capturing all those who require access (personal or vehicle) over the event weekend
- Questions will include: Businesses/Addresses, Names, Contact Details, Passes required, Parking permits or requirements, Medical requirements, additional adhoc business requirements

Accreditation Process – Application cont.:

- Accreditation will be confirmed, processed and printed
- As all those who receive accreditation will be in the event precinct, therefore as per COVID Safety Plan, we will need to collect information of all individuals tracking and tracing purposes. QR Code scanning TBC with Queensland Health
- Accreditation will gain them access to the CBD precinct only

Accreditation Process – delivery / collection:

- Accreditation packs will include all required personal accreditation and vehicle permits, along with information about access into the CBD event and contact information for accreditation queries
- Accreditation will be hand delivered to all business and residents in March
- For those not at businesses or at residents during the time of delivery, an Accreditation collection point will be set up for any accreditation that was not able to be hand delivered

Accreditation Process – delivery / collection cont.:

- The Accreditation collection point will be open throughout the week leading into the event and over the event weekend for collection, or to manage any queries, lost accreditation or issues that may arise
- There will be a dedicated event hotline phone number provided

Current COVID Climate

ACTION

- We are continually monitoring and taking the most current advice from Queensland Health. They will be on board through all planning process and we will continue to as restrictions change, ease or increase
- A detailed COVID Safe Event Plan is in the final stages for submission to Queensland Health for approval
- All entrant, spectators and businesses will be required to scan the event QR code upon entry into the venue
 - Working through a process to ensure this is quick and easy for all

Motorsport Activities

The motorsport activities at the event will be sanctioned and insured by both Motorsport Australia and the Australian National Drag Association (ANDRA). Their involvement is in line with all other major motorsport events across Australia, such as V8 Supercars and Formula 1. This will include, but is not limited to;

- Site visit/s from Motorsport Australia and ANDRA to inspect the motorsport activity locations.
- Motorsport Australia and ANDRA will review, approve and sign off on all motorsport precinct designs and event safety management
- Rockynats Motorsport Operation Plans and Risk Assessments will be reviewed and approved by Motorsport Australia and ANDRA
- Motorsport Australia and ANDRA will provide site safety consultation during the event
- Motorsport Australia and ANDRA will provide daily motorsport precinct sign off prior to competitions starting
