

VEHICLE JUDGING

Rockynats defines a street machine as a post-1948 street driven vehicle that has been restored, modified or customised.

To further identify other vehicle types, Hot Rods are pre-1948 vehicles given similar re-build treatment or as described by the ASRF handbook.

Points are awarded in the following areas taking into consideration:

BODYWORK assess the preparation of the body before paint is applied. Consideration is also given to gaps, straightness, quality and degree of difficulty of modifications to the body.

PAINT includes preparation, primer and overall finish in all areas of the vehicle.

INTERIOR key areas are creativeness, workmanship and attention to detail. Consideration all items visible from the doorjambs, dash, floor coverings, rear parcel, hood lining, seats, modified/fabricated panels, use of materials and fitment.

UNDERCARRIAGE includes the floor pan, substructure, driveline components, suspension components and all visible brackets, fuel lines etc on the underside of the car

ENGINE BAY reviews the fitment and finish of engines and accessories and all other components in the engine bay, the overall detail and enhancement.

ENGINEERING covers all non-factory modifications that would require a degree of manufacturing/ fabrication including driveline and suspension components.

BIKE JUDGING

Entrants wishing to be judged will need to be parked up in their relevant award category in the CBD precinct on Saturday. Officials will be on site to help you park up in the right place and the judging team will start judging once you're parked up and ready.

AWARD		DESCRIPTION
Best Softail	Winner	Best Harley-Davidson motorcycle within the Softail family such as Fatboy, Heritage, Breakout, Deuce and so on
Best Dyna	Winner	Best Harley-Davidson motorcycle with the Dyna family such as Fat Bob, Low Rider, Street Bob, Wide Glide and so on
Best Other Harley	Winner	Includes all other Harley-Davidson motorcycles not covered in Softail or Dyna platforms – e.g. Sportster, Street, V-Rod, Trike etc.
Best Tourer	Winner	Best bike in a Touring model of any brand
Best Vintage	Winner	Best bike, of any make, over 40 years old
Best American	Winner	Best American manufactured bike
Best European	Winner	Best European manufactured bike
Best Japanese	Winner	Best Japanese manufactured bike
