

TENT CITY TERMS & CONDITIONS AND SITE RULES

In addition to Rare Spares Rare Spares Rockynats ticketing terms and conditions, the below terms and conditions apply to all camping ticketholders patrons on campgrounds:

- 1. Camping bookings are strictly non-refundable.
- 2. We reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event for any reason. If the event, or any part of the event, is cancelled due to adverse weather or for any other cause reasonably beyond the event organisers' control, there is no right to refund or exchange and no obligation is assumed by the event organiser to arrange a substitute event.
- 3. Patrons must keep their site clean and tidy.
- 4. On arrival if you are issued with a campground wristband please treat your wristbands like cash & wear themat all times they will not be replaced if you lose them.
- 5. All vehicles, trailers, camping gear and patrons must strictly fit within allocated camping space/s.
- 6. Max capacity of patrons allowed within your campsite are 4 (small), 6 (medium), 8 (large).
- 7. Sites will be patrolled by an official each day. There will be a First Aid kit available from the Rent a Tent office. If it is anything more serious please dial 000 or go directly to the nearest hospital (Rockhampton Base Hospital). If you have any questions, queries or concerns please approach a member of staff or security.
- 8. Camping patrons must not cause damage to, improperly use or tamper with any public facility or camping infrastructure. You agree to indemnify the tent owners, staff and contractors against any loss or damage you may suffer arising out of your negligence or breach of these terms and conditions.
- 9. Camping patrons must not behave in a threatening or inappropriate manner (aggressive, riotous, abusive, or insulting actions) towards other patrons or event staff.
- 10. You must follow all reasonable directions given by staff and security.
- 11. Rare Spares Rockynats camping facilities operate on a strict No Open Fires Policy. Small gas BBQs and cooktops are permitted. All LPG bottles must be in good condition and within current stamped test date, LPG fittings must also be in good condition. Safety checks may be conducted and any unsafe items must be removed from the site. While fire extinguishers are available in the communal cooking areas, it is also recommended that campers bring their own fire extinguisher/fire blanket for individual campsites.
- 12. All camping patrons must adhere to onsite signed 8km/hr speed limits.
- 13. No drugs, weapons or dangerous items are permitted. Anyone found to be in possession of, supplying or consuming illicit drugs will be reported to Police immediately. This includes weapons and illegal substances or any items which may have the potential to be used in an illegal or offensive manner.
- 14. Smoking is permitted in designated smoking area only. Any patron caught smoking outside of the designated smoking area will be evicted.
- 15. Strictly no amplified music within the campground.
- 16. No animals are permitted into the campground with the exception of trained guide dogs, assistance dogs and Police support dogs.
- 17. Under 18 (minors) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian aged over 25 years.
- 18. Footwear must be worn at all times within the campgrounds.
- 19. Rare Spares Rockynats and/or Rockhampton Regional Council will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or theft of a person's personal property at the campground.

- 20.Patrons that leave valuable items at the campsite or in tents do so at their own risk.
- 21.Rare Spares Rockynats event organisers reserve the right to amend or vary the campground configuration and capacity. They reserve the right to deny admission to the area with reasonable cause.
- 22.Patrons must adhere to the event organisers' and Queensland Health's guidelines and health directions at all times.

Breaches of any of the above terms and conditions may result in removal from the camping site. Rare Spares Rockynatsevent organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to the campground to any patron who:

- Does not have a valid camping ticket
- Is in possession of any prohibited or illegal objects
- Does not adhere to the organisers' or Queensland Health's guidelines or health directions.

CAMPING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering Tent City, patrons, contractors and event staff agree to the following conditions of entry:

- Patrons must keep their site clean and tidy within clearly marked lines.
- All vehicles, trailers, camping gear and patrons must strictly fit within allocated camping space/s.
- Adhere to the event organisers' or Queensland Health's guidelines and health directions at all times.
- Must not behave in a threatening or inappropriate manner (aggressive, riotous, abusive, or insulting actions) towards other patrons or event staff.
- Must present their camping wristband to gain re-entry
- Rare Spares Rockynats event organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or evict patrons to/from the campground whodo not comply with the conditions of entry.

CAMPING SITE RULES

The following site rules apply to Tent City:

- 1. Must adhere to onsite 8km/hr speed limits
- 2. No alcohol
- 3. All fuel must remain within the contestants transport vehicle (as per the regulations, up to 150L may be stored per vehicle. All fuel must be stored in containers that meet the relevant Australian Standard for the type of fuel being stored.
- 4. No amplified music
- 5. No use of generators
- 6. No animals (other than trained guide dogs and assistance dogs)
- 7. No digging of holes
- 8. No star pickets
- 9. Use of tent pegs must be no greater than 150mm
- 10. Must adhere to onsite noise rules between 9.30pm and 7.00am
- 11. No unauthorised guests
- 12. Must maintain social distancing
- 13. No prohibited items (see below)

CAMPING RESTRICTED AND PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following restricted and prohibited items are not permitted into Tent City:

- Glass
- Illegal substances, including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs
- Flares or fireworks

- Laser pointers
- Weapons, or resemblance of weapons, including knives, firearms, blunt offensive objects, batons and those with sharp ends.
- Projectile items, including balls, Frisbees, rackets or similar objects
- Bicycles, skateboards, skates, scooters and helmets of any form
- Political or offensive materials
- Recording devices (for commercial purposes) and tripods
- Selfie sticks
- Flag poles of more than 1 metre in length / banners or flags larger than 1m x 2m
- Animals (other than trained guide dogs and assistance dogs)
- Musical instruments and noise makers, including drums, whistles, air horns and loud hailers
- All other items as determined by Rockhampton Regional Council that may cause injury, public nuisance or safety concerns
